Inaugural & Prize Distribution Function: The inaugural Function & Prize Distribution Function are compulsory for all players. The participants not attending the Prize Distribution Ceremony will not get the Prize as well as Certificate.

Age Limit: Players should be born on or after **01-01-1996**.

Age Proof: Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth.

Date of Birth Certificate & Date of Birth Registration. Participants date of birth Registration not within one year of Date of Birth will be allowed to participate in the state tournaments but his/her name will not be forwarded for National Championship until unless participant should go through the medical test before 31 Mar 2011 by AICF.

AOCA Registration of Players: All participants in the Championship should be registered with All Odisha Chess Association for the year 2011-12 by paying Rs. 150/- towards AOCA Registration fee. The amount should be deposited with the duly filled and signed AOCA player's registration form plus two passport size photo. Application forms are available in the website www.orissachess.com

Tournament Committee: A representative of the AOCA, two members from different participating District Associations and two members of the host Association will serve as the Tournament Committee.

System of Play: The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. Totally 9 rounds (boys) & 7 Rounds (Girls) shall be played unless otherwise decided by the Tournament Committee before the commencement of the championship. Number of Rounds may change due to availability of participant's strength.

Session: The rate of play shall be 60 minute with an increment of 30 seconds per move from Move number one. In the absence of digital clock the time control shall be 90 minutes each straight finish.

Chess Clocks: Players are requested to bring their own chess clocks.

Tie Break: Buchholz tie-break system will be applied.

: 3 :

Protest: Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 300/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee: Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member Appeals Committee shall be formed by the organizers. All the members and Reserves shall be from the different District. No member of the Committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own District is involved and in such case(s), the reserves shall take his place in the committee.

State Qualifiers : The Top four (4) players of Boys/Girls section will be selected to represent the State in the forthcoming National Sub Junior(U-15) Chess Championship to be held at **JN Stadium, Chennai, Tamilnadu from 01st May 2011 to 10th May 2011.**

Disqualification: No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter. The participants disregarding this rule will be suspended for one year.

Accommodation : Free dormitory accommodation, near by the venue, will be provided to all out station participants and one accompanying person with prior information before 01st Apr 2011.
